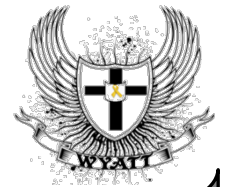

### Wyatt's Journey:

Wyatt Boynton-Deno, son of Justin and Stacy (Perzynski) Deno of Mantorville, was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumor on November 29th, 2011. Wyatt has undergone two surgeries. The first on November 23rd for biopsy and creation of a ventricle which enables spinal fluid to leave the brain, traveling to the rest of the spinal cord, and the second on November 25th for removal of a portion of the tumor. Next, Wyatt underwent 6 weeks of radiation and will soon be starting a 4 month course of chemotherapy. Wyatt also will be receiving stem cell transplants as well as his own harvested bone marrow intermittently throughout the course of treatment.

Wyatt is a witty second grade Kasson-Mantorville student and wrestler who played a key role in K-M Youth Wrestling's 2011 NYWA State Championship title. K-M Wrestling is partnering with friends and family to act as "Wyatt's Warriors" and win this battle with Wyatt.
